Directions to Keene State College/Young Student Center

From Concord.

Take I-89 North to Exit 5 (US-202 W/Rte-9 W exit) toward HENNIKER/KEENE. It's about 40 miles from there to Keene. Once you get to the Keene area pass the Washington Street Exit. Take the Rte-12 S/Rte-10 S/Rte-9 W exit ramp. Turn left at the T intersection onto NH-10/NH-12. Turn left at the first light, onto Winchester St. (an Applebee's Restaurant is at the corner). Follow Winchester St. approx. 1/2 mile to Madison Street. Turn right onto Madison Street, the Young Student Center is at the end of the street. Park in any of the parking lots marked with a CC sign.

From the Nashua area:

Take Route 101 West. The 3rd lighted intersection in Keene is Winchester Street. Turn right onto Winchester St. Follow Winchester St. approx. 1/2 mile to Madison Street. Turn right onto Madison Street, the Young Student Center is at the end of the street. Park in any of the parking lots marked with a CC sign.

The parking areas look like they require a permit. Don't worry, no tickets will be issued during our meeting.
